## Effect of polaron formation on electronic, charge and magnetic properties of Nb<sub>12</sub>O<sub>29</sub>

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**Abstract:** We present the *ab initio* study of different phases of  $Nb_{12}O_{29}$ , which has been done in the framework of density functional theory

using the onsite Hubbard-U correction applied to the Nb-d states. We vary the U parameter in between 0 and 7 eV and suggest U = 3.7-5.0 eV to be most appropriate for the description of Nb<sub>12</sub>O<sub>29</sub>. We show that one cannot get any adequate description of this oxide using the crystallographic unit cell but at least 3 times larger supercell is needed increased along the shortest lattice parameter *b* to accommodate lattice distortions associated with polaron formation. Our results obtained for the enlarged cells show the possibility of simultaneous co-existence of localized states (polaron formation) and delocalized states providing metal-like properties of Nb<sub>12</sub>O<sub>29</sub>, in qualitative agreement with available experimental data.

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
